#### CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

Employee evaluations and the safe return to the workplace environment pose an ongoing challenge to the physician's occupational medical practice. Lifestyle-related chronic conditions, behavioral issues, degenerative joint diseases and medication or substance abuse are common problems of today's workforce. These conditions and the lack of uniform assessments, definitive medical guidelines, and/or the requirement to adhere to federal standards all contribute to the difficulty of medical decision making in the workplace. The conference addresses many of these current occupational medicine issues and appropriate medical decision making for risk assessment.

### **CONFERENCE FOCUS**

This conference will focus on practical approaches and medical strategies to address common to complex occupational practice issues. Leading experts will identify appropriate medical guidelines and risk assessment methods to facilitate the occupational practitioner's medical decisions that impact employee health and safety in the workplace.

In addition, a unique insight to an electrical utility company will be provided, including an overview of the electrical industry, the work environment, safety issues, and specialized worker skills and tools.

Finally, an opportunity for participants to complete an isokinetic strength test (pre-placement or return to work) will be available.
